HEALTHY PUPILS CAPITAL FUND (HPCF)

The Healthy Pupils Capital Fund (HPCF) is intended to improve children's and young people's physical and mental health by improving and increasing availability to facilities for physical activity, healthy eating, mental health and wellbeing and medical conditions. The HPCF is investment raised by the Sugar Levy, the same as our PE and Sport Premium funding. Funding is provided from the Soft Drinks Industry Levy for 2018-19 only. The HPCF is being allocated utilising existing mechanisms for schools condition funding.

Miss Constantinou duly completed an application for this and we are delighted to report this has been successful and we have been given a grant of **£3 000**. This will be used to replace our outside container (full of playground and PE equipment) which is no longer fit for purpose.

Obviously we are absolutely thrilled as having a larger container will help with storing all our PE resources. Thank you Miss Constantinou.
